## People Photography

TIME: 10am to 5pm

LOCATION: Start at Studio 18 Upton Street, Launceston

**OVERVIEW:** Investigate the various aspects of people photography. Learn how to make great people pictures that are more than just a record of a persons face.

**OUTLINE/DESCRIPTION:** We start off in the studio with a short discussion on portrait theory, and look at some of the different styles of portraiture that have been used. We will discuss lens choice and look at the way different camera settings can effect the outcome of your photography. We will talk a bit about how we use light to bring out or hide facial features and how we can use our cameras to enhance or exaggerate our subjects features. We will then look at various indoor techniques using both available light and artificial light. After lunch, we will head outdoors to make some portraits and will look at how to handle various lighting conditions, and how to make a strong portrait regardless of the weather.

**OUTCOMES:** You will leave this workshop with a greater understanding of photographic portraiture, and some very practical ideas on how to handle a variety of lighting conditions. You will also learn techniques for capturing spontaneous and emotive portraits of people who may never have posed for a photograher before.

**WHO SHOULD DO THIS COURSE:** Anyone who has a reasonable grasp of digital photography. We would recommend that you have done our Introduction to Digital Photography workshop. Anyone with a sense of adventure who would like to start making photographic images that are out of the ordinary.

**COST:** \$295 per person and includes morning and afternoon tea.

digital SLR or compact camera  
a range of lenses  
flash  
spare batteries  
a tripod if possible  
anything else you would like to try or learn how to use  
And don't forget to bring your own lunch!!

**FOLLOW UP:** We will also present a 3 hour workshop specifically designed as a follow up to this workshop. Using images shot on this workshop, we will investigate ways to improve and enhance images using Photoshop (refer to Photoshop Skills for People Photographers workshop information sheet).
